The Travel Awards were established as part of CRESP to support CRESP funded Postdoctoral Fellows and CRESP supported PhD students to present their research project at national or international conferences, thereby facilitating research translation.

- Any unspent funds must be returned to CRESP.
- Successful applicants must submit a brief Report on Research Travel within one month of their return.
- Successful applicants may be asked to provide a CRESP newsletter piece on their trip.
